



Clarification pertaining to the EPASD Livestream learning option in place for parents, guardians, and students:

**Livestream instruction is intended for students who have a pre-existing medical condition considered high risk, have family members with pre-existing medical conditions considered high risk, or students and or parent(s) / guardian(s) don't feel comfortable immediately returning to any form of face-to-face instruction.**

**Livestream instruction is not what East Pennsboro Area School District is recommending for every student in the district. We feel that students attending school in the current Level II (Blended Learning Model) is the best option.**

In the livestream learning option, under the Level II Blended Learning plan, a student signed up for Livestream Learning would only livestream with his / her teacher(s) on the days he / she would have been scheduled to physically be in school.

For instance, a student in Group A is scheduled to be in school on Mondays and Wednesdays. These are the days of the week that a livestream student will view his / her teacher(s) and classes via a livestream link.

The other days of the week, Tuesday, Thursday, and Friday the student will participate in remote, online learning activities that his / her teacher(s) assigns.

If at any time during the school year the district moves to Level III (100% face-to-face instruction in school), then livestream students will participate in classes via a livestream link every day of the week.
