June 6<sup>th</sup>, 2019

6:00 PM: Report to the Forum with Cap and Gown. The commencement ceremony will start promptly at 7:00 PM. Seniors may pick up their diploma back stage after commencement. There is free on-street parking around the Forum after 6:00 PM, as well as various parking garages (may require a fee).

A ticket will be essential to attend the commencement ceremony. 6 (six) tickets will be issued with cap and gown to all participating seniors. It is necessary to limit the number of tickets due to the capacity restrictions of the Forum. It is the Forum's policy that everyone attending **MUST** be in their own seat no matter the age (no sitting on laps). Ticket sales will open on Tuesday, May 14<sup>th</sup> at 7:05 AM for \$35.00 each. With a limited number of tickets, initial orders will have a max of 4 tickets per senior. After Monday, May 27<sup>th</sup>, any remaining tickets will be sold on a first come, first serve basis. Please make checks to EPHS.

**\*\*** When submitting a ticket request, please include either check or cash in a **sealed envelope**. On the outside of the envelope, please include senior's name, # of tickets and total amount included. Please turn envelopes into the main office. Tickets will be time stamped and processed in the order received. Once processed, student will be notified. Please note any additional tickets will be included with your seniors 6 tickets and distributed with their cap & gown.

Commencement is a formal occasion. Boys are required to wear a white collared shirt, black pants, black shoes and tie (bow tie acceptable). Girls are required to wear either a white dress or white blouse and either white pants or skirt and white shoes. Mr. Bucher discussed this during the senior meeting on 5/3/19. Seniors, parents, family and friends are expected to act in a dignified manner. At no time should there be whistling or improper conduct for the occasion. Please do not applaud the graduates until all have left the stage.

Pictures may be taken, but not from the area where the graduates are seated. Videotaping will only be permitted from regular seats or from the rear of the Forum. *The ceremony will be professionally recorded* and DVD's will be available for a cost of \$30.00 each.
