Good morning EPASD Families and Community,

On Tuesday, July 14th, 2020, the East Pennsboro Area School District School Board met in a special meeting to present the Reopening Plan for the 2020-2021 school year. Our Reopening Plan is the culmination of months of work from our administrative team, School Board, Board Education Committee, and key members of our faculty and community. In early June, our plan began to take a definite shape, and we sought out information from all of you through a survey, to gauge how our plan met your comfort levels.

The plan has three distinct levels that will be enacted based off of a combination of guidance from the PA Department of Health, State Government officials, and careful monitoring of conditions specific to our own communities of Enola and Camp Hill. The levels range from 100% online distance learning (Level I) to 50% student split rotating between in-person and online learning (Level II), to 100% in-person learning (Level III). In regards to Levels II and III, increased measures and guidance will take place to ensure the health and safety of all students, faculty, and staff.

Attached to this email are two documents: the brief summary of the Re-entry plan and the overall parameters of the curriculum. If you would like to view the more detailed and comprehensive re-entry plan, please visit our website where it is located on the homepage under announcements. We are also in the process of creating a FAQ page on our website that will be frequently updated for your convenience. A survey will be sent out to you next Tuesday, in which you will be asked how your family anticipates to adapt to the re-entry plan.

This is a very difficult situation for all of us. Health, safety, and welfare of our students and staff are our primary concern. Please know I appreciate all of your best efforts to make this transition successful. Thank you for your patience and understanding as we navigate these unprecedented times to ensure the health and safety of our students, staff, and community.
