- Escape (Run)....Get to a safe place outside
- Enhance (Hide)....At your location, build a safe place and prepare



Engage (Fight).....To disengage...
 and then quickly escape to safety

### Three Strategies to Help You Stay **SAFE**

# #1 STRATEGY: ESCape to a safe place!

- If in Doubt.... ESCAPE TO SAFETY
  - Your teacher will pick the safest route
  - Look for secondary exits
- With those around you
- Your teacher will call 911 as soon as possible


#### Where to Run – RALLY POINTS

#### **Front of School:**

- Woods beside MS
- Woods behind Admin bldg

#### **Back of School:**

- Woods beside MS
- Grassy area behind stadium
- Softball/Playground area by EPE

### Strategy #2: Enhance your shelter- make a safe place

- Barricade
- Improvised secondary locking devices
- Prepare to engage
- Seek escape route to safety
- Consider windows and alternative exits

## Improvised Secondary locking devices

- Coat hanger
- Belts
- Computer cord
- Wires
- Wire Ties
- Extension Cord
- Backpack Straps



#### Doesn't Have To Be Sophisticated









### Strategy #3: Engage!

- Ultimate goal- Engage so you can DISENGAGE and escape to safety
- Utilize Situational Awareness
- Work as a group when you can
- Commit to the plan



#### **ANYTHING CAN WORK**



















#### **REVIEW:**

- If you ESCAPE, meet at RALLY POINTS
- If you lockdown, ENHANCE your barricade
- If you ENGAGE, Escape to RALLY POINTS
- Leave your stuff behind
- Tell what you know to teachers and first responders

#### When The Police Arrive...

- Arms raised, open hands
- Do not run at officers
- LISTEN to their instructions
- Do Not Touch Weapons if you find them

#### All Clear!

- After the threat has been neutralized, first responders will announce "All Clear" via loudspeakers and directions will be given.
- Alerts/Messages will be sent to cellphones/computers.
- Teachers and students will then proceed to "Rally Points" to await further directions.

#### **Reunification:**

- Students and staff will then either walk or be transported to a "reunification site".
- This site will be designated by the first responders and/or district administration.
- The options may include EPAHS, EPE, Central Penn College or an area church.
- Parents will be directed via the media to the site where student pick up by parent or guardian will be coordinated and documented.

#### **Discussion points:**

#### If we decide to Escape (run).....

- Which exit?
- If blocked, what is our alternate?
- Where is our safety/cover area(s)?
- Where is our closest "rally" point?

#### **Discussion points:**

#### If we decide to Engage (hide).....

- We do not hide ....we ACT!
- How can we prevent entry?
  - > Mechanical devices: belt, book bag, cord
  - ➤ Blockade: File cabinet, desks
- Is there an alternate escape route?
  - ➤ Windows, doors....if so, get out!

#### **Discussion points:**

#### If we decide to Enhance (fight)....

- Find items that can be used to distract, disarm and disable the intruder.
  - > Book bags, books, fire extinguisher, laptop
- Commit to the act!
- "Engage to Disengage" and then run to safety

#### **Final Key Points**

• **Escape** to Safety with others if you can



- Enhance your lockdown- make a safe place until help arrives
- Engage to Disengage then escape to safety
- Get those injured outside to help

#### **Questions?**

#### **FAQ:**

"Could I just go home when I run?" - We prefer that you do not. It will easier for us to account for you if you run to a rally point and then reunification with your class.

What if I am in the hallway when this happens? - Students need to clearly understand that the doors will remain locked once drill starts and that it is up to them to find another classroom or run outside.

What would we do if the intruder came in the doors of the cafeteria while we were eating lunch? -The monitors need to have their own discussion about where the multiple exit points are (we can then share that with the students at lunch)

What if we need more time for our discussion? We would recommend continuing during Discovery the next time you see them.
