# Being Safe is Important

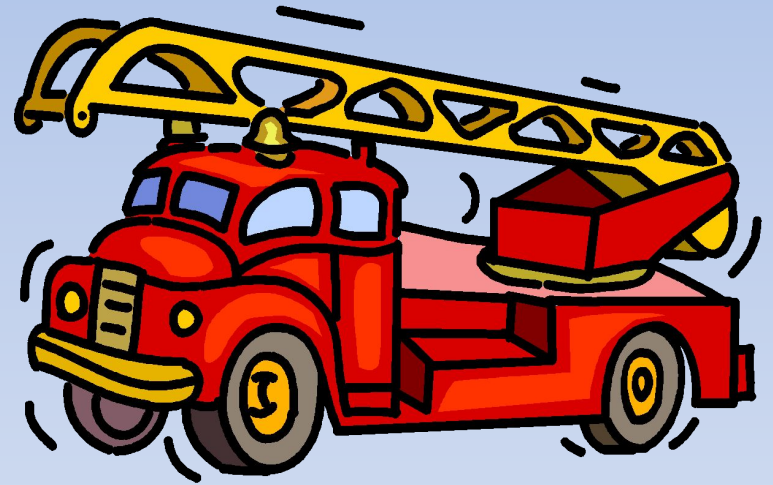
- We want you to be safe at home.
- We want you to be safe on the bus.
- We want you to be safe in school.
- We want you to be safe wherever you are.

# Being Safe is Important

- No matter where you are, you should know how to keep yourself safe.
- What do you do if you see a fire?
- What do you do if you see a stranger?
- What do you do if you don't feel safe?

# Fires

- Every October, firefighters talk to us about being safe. We learn how to be safe if there is a fire.
- Every month, we practice how to line up and safely leave the building if there is a fire during our fire drills.



# Bad Weather

- If the weather is bad, we come inside.
- If the weather is very bad, we might go to a safe place to take cover.



# Strangers

- If someone you don't know approaches you, you should run away and get help.
- Never go anywhere with a stranger.



# Strangers in School

- A stranger *could* come into the school who is dangerous.
- We call that person an “intruder”.
- The teachers will make sure you know what to do.

# Intruder in School

- Sometimes, we'll need to do one of these three strategies to stay safe:

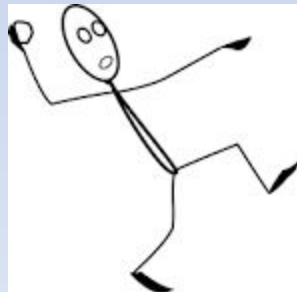
– RUN



-HIDE



– THROW

# RUN



If it's not safe to be inside, you should go outside.

- It's okay to go fast.
- You should go to where the safe grown-ups tell you.
- When you get there, wait for grown-ups or police to come.

# HIDE

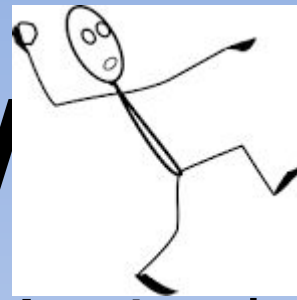


If you are inside and it's not safe to go outside, your teacher will lock the door.

- You may need to help your teacher pile things in front of the door.
- You should wait in your classroom for police to tell you everything is okay.
- Your teacher might tell you to climb out a window.



# THROW



If the intruder is close and you're in danger, you can throw something at him to help you get away.

- Throwing something can slow down the intruder and help you get away.
- You won't get in trouble if you throw something at an intruder and run away.



# Intruder in School

- If there is an intruder in the school, we will call the police (just like we call the firefighters when there is a fire).
- When they come, always listen to what they tell you to do.



**They will keep you safe!**

# It's OK to Feel Afraid

- Everyone feels afraid sometimes.
- If an intruder comes, your teacher will help you know what to do.
- Remember to stay calm, listen, and try your best to be brave.
- It's a big job keeping yourself safe, and you can help us by doing these things and following directions.
