

**EAST PENNSBORO AREA HIGH SCHOOL
NOMINATION FORM FOR 2018-2019 PANTHER ALUMNI WALL OF HONOR**

The East Pennsboro Area School District is seeking nominations for graduates to be inducted into the Alumni Wall of Honor. A graduate can be recognized for one of the following categories: Service to Humanity, Loyalty to EPASD, Outstanding Achievement in Athletics or Outstanding Achievement in a Chosen Profession.

Nomination Guidelines

- Selections limited to 2 per year.
- Once a person is inducted, he/she will not be considered for future inclusion in another category.
- Current staff members are not eligible for nomination.
- The individual must have graduated from East Pennsboro Area High School and attended for at least two years.
- Candidates not selected in the year of nomination will be reconsidered for a maximum of 5 years.
- An individual may not nominate himself/herself.
- Nominee for Outstanding Achievement in Athletics must have graduated at least 10 years prior to selection and will be considered based on high school and post high school achievements in athletics.
- Nominee for Outstanding Achievement in a Chosen Profession or for Service to Humanity must have graduated at least 15 years prior to selection.
- Nominee for Loyalty to East Pennsboro Area High School must have graduated at least 15 years prior to selection.

How to Submit Nomination:

1. Complete this Nomination Form with complete and accurate information.
2. Provide a narrative containing substantive background information.
3. Attach a separate sheet of paper which contains a list of the Nominee’s specific contributions and achievements; a resume for the nominee may be attached in addition to this list of achievements. Please provide enough detail so that the committee can make an informed decision.

**The Wall of Honor Committee Members:
Criteria for Panther Alumni Wall of Honor Recipients**

For your information:

- Four of six committee members must vote their approval in order for a nominee to be inducted into the Wall of Honor. We will select a maximum of 2 per school year.
- All portions of the nomination submission must be received by February 8, 2019: Nomination Form, narrative and list of achievements.
- All inductees must meet the nomination guidelines as stated on nomination form.
- Please rate the nominees in order you would induct them into the wall of honor, noting that only 2 will be selected per year.

Service to Humanity:

- Nominee must be of outstanding character and be able to serve as a positive role model to young people and our community.
- Nominee for Service to Humanity must have graduated at least 15 years prior to selection.
- Active member in a community organization, leadership in community, contribution that improves or strengthens the community are examples of this category.

Loyalty to East Pennsboro Area High School:

- Nominee must be of outstanding character and be able to serve as a positive role model to young people and our community.
- Nominee for Loyalty to East Pennsboro Area High School must have graduated at least 15 years prior to selection.
- Donation of time, expertise, or resources of the nominee.
- Volunteer to assist teachers, coaching teams, involvement in extracurricular programs.
- Outstanding service as a district teacher, administrator or staff member (After Retiring).

Outstanding Achievement in a Chosen Profession:

- Nominee must be of outstanding character and be able to serve as a positive role model to young people and our community.
- Nominee must have graduated at least 15 years prior to selection.
- Awards, degrees, recognition, invention, start of business, artistic achievements, development of new process or procedure.

Outstanding Achievement in Athletics:

- Nominee must be of outstanding character and be able to serve as a positive role model to young people and our community.
- Nominee for Outstanding Achievement in Athletics must have graduated at least 10 years prior to selection.
- Nominee will be considered based on high school and post high school achievements in athletics.
